British R&B singer/songwriter Jay Sean is notable for being one of the first British-Asian crossover stars and also for his international popularity. The lead single off Jay Sean's album, "Down" featuring Lil Wayne has achieved platinum status by selling over 1 million units in the U.S.

Roscoe Dash is a trendsetting performer, hailing from Atlanta, GA. The rapper made major noise in '09 with the party-starting radio smash "All The Way Turnt Up!" featuring Soulja Boy. Now, with the impending release of his upcoming debut *Ready Set Go!*, Dash will soon write his own page in history.

Hailing from the West Indies, Shontelle is a 23 year-old singer, songwriter, rising star, and aspiring lawyer. Shontelle is best known for her hit song, "Impossible," and performed this past summer at an event in Clinton Square.

Lloyd Banks is a rap artist of rap group G-Unit, hailing from Queens, NY. One of his latest songs out is "Beamer Benz or Bentley" featuring Juelz Santana.

The New Boyz, consisting of Ben J and Legacy, started in 2009 as a Los Angeles underground youth phenomenon. They became rising stars on a national level in just a few months due to the success of their song "You're a Jerk," which sold over 53 thousand copies on iTunes its first week.
